

EADPH/SESPO Pre -Congress Workshop on Wednesday, 17 October 2018

The Boundaries between Caries and Periodontal Diseases.

What are the Implications for Education in Dental Public Health?

A Pre-Congress workshop will be held on Wednesday, 17 October 2018, at the Centro Cultural Sa Nostra (same conference centre that the EADPH/SESPO Congress will take place). There is no registration fee for the workshop and tea/coffee and lunch will be provided at no cost to the delegates. Attendance at the workshop is limited to 50 delegates. The workshop is supported by Colgate.

The workshop will be held from 09.00 until 15.30. Four speakers, who were each members of one of the four groups at the EFP/ORCA workshop, will each give an overview of the content of the papers produce by the group that they took part in and how they may impact on education in Dental Public Health. After the first two presentations there will be small group discussions on the papers and their implications. After the second two presentations there will be further small group discussions. Reporters from each of the small groups will report the recommendations from their small groups in a plenary session. A workshop will conclude with a short presentation on the impact of dental caries and periodontal diseases on general health.

Aim

The aim of the workshop is to ensure that education in Dental Public Health is based on the latest evidence and that lecturers are aware of this evidence which is set out in 13 position papers produced during a joint European Federation of Periodontology (EFP) and European Organisation for Caries Research (ORCA) workshop held in Segovia in November 2016.

These papers were published in the Journal of Clinical Periodontology (JCP) in March 2017, Volume 44, Supplement S18 and can be accessed from JCP website for free. They were produced by four working groups.

Group 1 Role of microbial biofilms in the maintenance of oral health and the development of dental caries and periodontal diseases.

Group 2 Interaction of lifestyle, behaviours or systematic diseases with oral health: dental caries and periodontal diseases.

Group 3 Prevention and control of dental caries and periodontal diseases at individual and population level.

Group 4 Age-related effects on oral health, dental caries and periodontal diseases.
